Eligibility requirements

- applicant must hold a valid Rocky Hill library card

Selection criteria

Applications will be evaluated by a committee composed of members of the Friends Executive Board. Selection will be based on the following:

- academic record
- school and community involvement/work experience
- one faculty recommendation
- a 250-500 word essay on “Why our public library is important to me and my community” submitted on a separate page
